As you know, our Year 11 students will be sitting 'mock' GCSE examinations at the end of this term. This is a valuable experience for them and will provide the students, their teachers, and their families, with essential information about their strengths and areas for development so that they can address these over the coming months. Please find attached the timetable for the examination period. Students should be starting to revise their work independently and will also be preparing in class with their teachers. **All students are required to attend their examinations or, when they are not sitting an exam, their usual timetabled lessons.**

On **Monday 23rd and Tuesday 24th November** Art Examinations (Art, Textiles, Photography), Latin and MFL orals are timetabled. All other students will be given the opportunity to carry out supervised or independent study when they are not in an examination on these two days. Any student who has coursework to complete should use this time to do so.

On these days we have put into place the following flexible arrangements:

Either: Practical examinations for those who study **ART/TEXTILES/PHOTOGRAPHY/FRENCH/GERMAN**. MFL students will be given a fifteen minute appointment to sit a Language oral. Students must ensure they attend for their timetabled session.

Or: **ALL OTHER STUDENTS** will be expected to spend the time preparing for their GCSE's. Parents may arrange for their child to carry out this work at home, or send their child into school.

If you would like us to supervise your child working in school on these 2 days, please complete the slip below and return by Friday 23rd October so that we can plan the provision of appropriate rooms and staffing.

Please note that a copy of the timetable will also be on the school website from next week.
